## COMMANDER'S REPORT— BY JAKE SCHU

I want to thank all of the officers and members who contributed time and effort to help with our projects and events in the past year. Our programs have been successful because of your dedication. We have attended and supported the following activities and in 2018:

- 3" M5 Gun painting project is moving slowly but is still being planned. Thanks to Don Schram for raising funds to support this effort and Jim Wolfe for his time and efforts!
- Our Post, along with AMVETS Post 7275 and VFW Post 7275 participated on the Depew Founder's Day event and parade on July 21st.
- We can always use help with our events and committees. Please consider becoming active in your Post. Many
  are doing double duty to fill needed positions.
- I have attended all but a couple of Erie County meetings and continue to do so as best I can.
- I continue to support Legion websites for Post 1528, Erie County and ECAL Veterans for Veterans. The County Legion has a website and can be found at the following URL: http://www.eriecountyal.org
- There have been a few changes to the officers list since our elections in May. Jack Betz is now our Adjutant and Rich Walczak is now Finance Officer, as Don Schram stepped down due to health reasons. Mike Johnson remains membership Chair and Jack Betz remains Graves Registration Chair.
- Depew Post 1528 again did the cooking for the Special Olympics party at the Lamm Post this year. Thanks to
  Dick Bulman and Chet Pawlowski for their time and efforts. We grilled about 140 hamburgers! Post 1528 also
  donates to this event every year.
- Remember to support the other veterans organizations in our area. We have AMVETS Post 14, AMVETS Post 7275 and VFW Post 7275 within a mile or two of Post 1528. Other Legion posts have breakfasts, dinners and events as well. If we support them, they will support us. We want to be good neighbors in our community and remember, we are all Veterans!
- Lastly, I will not seek reelection for Commander in 2019. After seven straight years, it is time to turn over the gavel to a new Commander. I am proud to say that during my tenure, we have dedicated a WWI monument in the Lancaster Veterans Park; Korean War and Vietnam War monuments in Depew Veterans park and relocated the 3" M5 gun to Depew's Veterans Park, including a new concrete pad and dedication plaque. All of the planning, engineering and organization for these projects was done in-house by members of our Post and myself. Our Grave Registration Project was implemented in 2012 and has grown substantially under guidance and due-diligence from our Graves Registration Chair, Jack Betz. We now have at least two Executive Committee meetings every year, which had not been done in many years. This is comprised of our Post officers, any Past Post Commanders who wish to attend, our Membership Chair Mike Johnson and Quartermaster Wally Waiss. This year, meetings were again held in February and August. A revised Constitution and Bylaws was compiled and issued in 2016, for the first time since 1991. We started issuing printed meeting agendas and minutes in 2012 and we started performing the POW/MIA ceremony at our meetings, complete with the ceremonial table, in 2014. We also perform this ceremony annually on Veterans day at the Elks dinner. All this has been accomplished by our Post, with valuable input and effort from our members, officers and committee chairs. We have a website, Facebook page and we publish our newsletter in the format you see, starting from 2012. Last year, we

## POST 1528 GRAVES REGISTRATION PROJECT— JACK BETZ, CHAIR

I have been very busy redoing the records for our deceased veterans that reside in the five cemeteries under Post 1528's jurisdiction. This task includes compiling cemetery records, fragmented and incomplete records that are over 100 years old. Since volunteering in 2015 date Jack has over 3,000 hours and has walked over 46,000 grave sites and identified more than 3,800 veteran's graves. The following is a breakdown by cemetery: Lancaster Rural: 85% complete 19,200 sites; 700 veterans / St. ADALBERTS: 20,100 sites; 1,688 veterans / St. AUGUSTINES: 5,330 sites; 603 veterans / Sacred heart: 1,340 sites; 167 veterans / St. MARYS: is about 30% complete with about 500 veterans. There are also approximately 500 graves that have not been verified as veterans. I will be posting a list in a future news letter asking for your help to identify these veterans so they can be added to our data base. As always, if you know of a veteran that may be buried in one of these cemeteries, please con-

tact Jack so that he may follow up on that person and add them to our data base.
