POST 1528 GRAVES REGISTRATION PROJECT— BY JACK BETZ, CHAIR

With help from my granddaughter, I have completed grave registration work on 4 of the 5 cemeteries under Post 1528's jurisdiction. This includes compiling cemetery records, fragmented and incomplete records that cover deceased Veterans from the Indian Wars to present service. In the past 4+ years since volunteering Jack has spent over 5,000 hours and has walked over 48,500 grave sites and identified and confirmed over 4,500 veteran's graves. As always, if you know of a veteran that may be buried in one of these cemeteries, please contact Jack so that he may follow up on that person and add them to our data base.

The following is a breakdown by cemetery: <u>LANCASTER RURAL</u>: 100% complete 19,200 sites; 790 Veterans <u>St. ADALBERTS</u>: 100% complete 20,100 sites; 2,161 Veterans <u>St. AUGUSTINES</u>: 100% complete 5,330 sites; 602 Veterans <u>SACRED HEART</u>: 100% complete 1,340 sites; 170 Veterans. <u>St. MARYS</u>: 95% complete 11,500 sites; 768 Veterans.
